KING'S CHRISTIAN SCHOOL'S DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

- 1. We believe that the Bible is the Word of God, verbally inspired and without error as originally written, and that it is the only infallible rule of faith and practice for the Christian.
- 2. There is one God, eternally existent, Creator of the heavens and the earth. He is a triune being: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- 3. The Lord Jesus Christ is fully God who took on flesh through the virgin birth and dwelt on earth with a sinless human nature.
- 4. God is absolutely sovereign. Nevertheless, in His sovereignty, He gave man a free will to accept or reject the salvation that He has provided through His only Son.
- 5. Each member of the human race is fallen, sinful, and lost.
- 6. Man is saved by grace through faith and no merit, works, or effort of man enters into his salvation; it is a free gift received by believing on the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 7. Christ paid the penalty for our sin through his death, burial and resurrection.
- 8. The Church began with the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost and is composed of all believers.
- 9. Every child of God possesses eternal life, being justified by faith, sanctified by God, and sealed with the Holy Spirit; he is safe and secure for all eternity and cannot lose his salvation.
- 10. We believe in the personal, pre-tribulational rapture and pre-millennial return of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.
- 11. God can heal, but physical healing is not in the atonement. God heals miraculously today when it is His perfect will to do so.
- 12. The gift of tongues (languages) was a manifestation of the Spirit's power solely for the demonstration of God's wisdom, purpose and power in the establishment of the early church, and was always in a language that was used.
- 13. The child of God is not under the Law but under grace. He or she is saved by grace and disciplined by our Heavenly Father who chastens His children.
- 14. Repent (metanoeo) means a change of mind. Repentance in salvation means a change of mind from any idea of a religion that man may have and an acceptance of God's way of salvation. Repentance does not in any sense include a demand for a change of conduct in order to be saved.
